

Pupil Premium 2015/16

Our Pupil Premium allocation for 2015-16 is £255,000 and we aim to enrich and support students learning experiences within their education at The Westgate School. We aim to continue supporting our pupil premium students through interventions and strategies that allows them to make positive progress.

Throughout the year all staff will monitor student attainment and the funding will be used to enrich their learning experiences through:

- Educational visits
- Additional music tuition
- Providing equipment/resources where needed
- Literacy and numeracy resources
- Sound Training
- Support for extracurricular clubs

Through the constant monitoring that takes place by the Pupil Premium coordinator we aim to support the students learning, if they are below national expectations by:

- Individual and group intervention
- Increasing parental awareness of attainment through information evenings
- Whole school focus on teaching and learning lead by SLT
- Improve CPD training for support staff
- Increase literacy and numeracy support staff
- Revision workshops
