- FOCUSED

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PUT YOUR PHONE AWAY. TURN THE MUSIC OFF. REMOVE DISTRACTIONS. STAY HYDRATED. BE IN THE RIGHT PHYSICAL PLACE TO REVISE. BE IN THE RIGHT FRAME OF MIND TO REVISE.

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START EARLY TO REDUCE STRESS. REVISE LITTLE OFTEN. MAKE A REVISION TIMETABLE AND COMMIT TO IT. PLAN 30 MINUTE SESSIONS. AIM TO COMPLETE 2/3 SESSIONS A DAY. TAKE SHORT REGULAR BREAKS BETWEEN SESSIONS.





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ENGAGE YOUR BRAIN BY ACTIVELY CREATING REVISION RESOURCES. TEST YOURSELF, GET OTHERS TO TEST YOU. PRACTICE EXAM TECHNIQUES BY WRITING OR PLANNING ANSWERS. REVISE WHAT YOU STRUGGLE WITH FIRST.
